

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-4

Ordinance Levying and Assessing Property Tax for Bethalto Public Library District
of the County of Madison, State of Illinois
for the Fiscal Year Beginning the 1st Day of July, 2022,
and ending the 30th Day of June, 2023

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Bethalto Public Library District, in the County of Madison and State of Illinois, did on the 8th day of September, 2022, pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance (Ordinance No. 2022-2) for said Library District for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published as provided by law after its passage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Bethalto Public Library District, in the County of Madison and State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the total sum of FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$560,700) composed as follows: The sum of FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$447,250), being the amount deemed required for the necessary corporate purposes of Bethalto Public Library District, Madison County, Illinois; the sum of NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$19,000), being required for the payment of employer contributions of Bethalto Public Library District to the Medicare and Social Security Fund; the sum of TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$12,000), being required for the payment of employer contributions of Bethalto Public Library District to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; the sum of SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$6,800), being required for the payment of the professional opinion of an accountant and other auditing expenses from an Audit Fund; the sum of SIXTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$16,000) for the purpose of payments of premiums due for the purchase of liability insurance, workers' compensation and unemployment insurance, property damage (fire) insurance, and legal fees for defending or otherwise protecting itself against liability from a Liability Fund; the sum of FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$59,650), being required for the maintenance, repairs, and alterations of library buildings and equipment from a Maintenance Fund, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed upon and against all taxable property within this Library District according to the full fair value as established and ascertained for State and County purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, and the Board of Trustees of the Bethalto Public Library District having on the 8th day of September, 2022, duly passed and adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, and said Ordinance having been duly published in a newspaper of general circulation within this Public Library District, this Board finds that the specific purposes and the specific amounts provided for in said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, are required to be levied for the necessary purposes of the Bethalto Public Library District.

Section 2: The Secretary of the Board of Trustees of Bethalto Public Library District is hereby directed to file a duly certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Madison County, Illinois, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2022; and said County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to extend the said tax so levied by this Ordinance, according to law, against all taxable property within the Bethalto Public Library District. The Secretary of Bethalto Public Library District shall also file on or before the last Tuesday of December 2022, duly certified copies of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and this Ordinance with the Bethalto Public Library where they shall be available for public inspection as provided by law.

I further certify that annexed hereto as a part of said Tax Levy Ordinance No. 2022-4 is a correct copy of the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance No. 2022-2 as passed by the Board of Trustees of said Library District at a meeting thereof held on the 8th day of September, 2022; that said Ordinance was duly passed by ye and nay vote thereon with at least a majority of all the Board of Trustees having voted ye on the adoption and passage thereof; and that thereafter said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was printed and published in a public secular newspaper with general circulation in said Library District.

I further certify that the Bethalto Public Library District requires the sum of \$560,700 as is more fully shown in said Tax Levy Ordinance No. 2022-4 and the annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance to be levied on the taxable property in said District for the year 2022.

I further certify that said Ordinances have not been amended or repealed but remain in full force and effect at this time.
